



Archery New Brunswick Policy - ANB Provincial Team Program

Approved October 17, 2018

Scores used

Scores from the previous ANB's fiscal year will be used.

Amendment to the Policy

Changes, modifications, additions and/or deletions are approved by the ANB executive.

Purpose & Scope:

Target and 3D events are a rich part of our provincial archery history. For years people have been competing at these events with the hopes of qualifying for some of the most esteemed archery competitions such as the Olympics, World Target Championships, World Field Championships, World 3D Championships, Canada Games, IBO Championships, Canadian National 3D, Field and Target Championships, Atlantic Target and 3D Championships and the Archery NB 3D and Target Championships.

Archery NB (ANB) is eager in supporting as many archers as possible with the resources available each year to continue past efforts to increase the number of ANB archers who achieve success when participating in national and international archery events and competitions and to encourage the development of archery proficiency and increase the competitiveness of New Brunswick Target and 3D archers.

The intent of the Provincial Team Program is:

- To strive for excellence, provide our athletes the means and avenues to achieve success.
- To prepare New Brunswick Archers to compete more effectively at Provincials, Nationals, Canada Games and International events.
- To field strong teams of NB archers to compete at the Canadian 3D and Target National Championships.
- To provide funding and development opportunities for archers dedicated to the Provincial Team programs.
- To ensure that developing archers can gain experience on the national scene.
- To promote the sport of archery by using Provincial Team members as our sport ambassadors.
- To increase the number of New Brunswick archers at Provincial, Canadian Championships and International events.

As ANB Provincial Team members, participants will be eligible to receive:

- Instructional sessions with qualified coaches, instructional videos, video sessions, and team practice sessions
- Access to Sport Psychologists, Nutritionists, and other archers.

General Team (3D and Target) Criteria:

1. The Provincial Team Program, which is comprised of Team NB 3D and Team NB Target, is open to all ANB Members in good standing and who are permanent residents of New Brunswick.
2. NB Archers attending a post-secondary institution outside NB are eligible to apply for the Provincial Team.
3. Teams may consist of up to 3 archers from each category; 2 at the Team NB level and 1 at Team NB Development level. If more archers in any one category exceed the minimum qualifying scores, then the top 3 will be selected.
4. Team members must sign an ANB Athlete Contract. This contract will include provisions such as keeping team morale and getting along with team members. In addition the Team Manager/Coach and any other volunteers shall be required to hold events to build team spirit/morale before the Team attends the National Championships.
5. Team members will demonstrate commitment to the team by attending team meetings, practice sessions, and fundraising events when called to do so.
6. Archers must submit a **Team application between December 15 and January 15 of each year indicating their intent of trying out for the team**. A signed Athlete's contract must accompany the application. Athletes meeting team criteria will be notified by February 15th if they have been selected to be on the Team.
7. Once you have been selected, team members must submit a registration fee each fiscal year of \$150 and must be submitted by March 15.
8. Athletes may choose to apply for both the Target Team and the 3D Team by submitting an application form and fee for each team.
9. Applications will be reviewed and confirmed with the applicant. Applications must define the archers' shooting class based on the Archery Canada/World Archery (AC/WA) categories. However, applicants will have to declare their intended discipline at the time of application. Qualifying scores must be from the declared discipline.
10. Athletes must be a Provincial Team member to receive support and services provided by the Provincial Team Program. A parent or guardian will normally accompany Team members under 18 years of age to go to out of Province events (Guardian/Parent is self-

funded). The Team Manager shall ensure that archers may participate even if a parent cannot for whatever reason accompany the archer by making sure that sufficient adults will be making the trip to ensure that the team will be suitably “chaperoned” for the duration of the event. ANB shall ensure that the Team Manager, coach and volunteers/guardians have adhered to ANB’s Volunteer Screening Policy.

11. Athletes not abiding by ANB conduct standards as stated in the Provincial Team Athletes Contract shall be subject to disciplinary action.
12. Funding shall be based on estimated expenses, determined by the Treasurer/Team Manager for accommodations, meals, registration and travel using a central point of departure in NB. The estimated costs will assume that team members will travel together as much as possible when travelling by car and sharing hotel rooms (eg. 3 team members/car, 2 team members/hotel rooms). Airfare is based on economy airfare. This will be used for estimating purposes and to determine the amount of assistance.
13. Team members shall be responsible for making their own travel arrangements and submitting travel claims for reimbursement after the National Championships. However, travel and accommodation arrangements will be coordinated with the ANB Team Manager to ensure that wherever possible Team Members travel to and from the shooting venue and hotel and stay as a team. Members not travelling with the Team shall clear that with the Team Manager. In such cases, these members shall receive the same funding considerations as all other Team Members.
14. Provincial Team Members are expected to train independently outside team and individual practice sessions.
15. Team Members are required to purchase/own a current team uniform. The uniform will consist of the current ANB Team shirt. Individuals that are accepted to the team (the first time only) shall receive one shirt from ANB free of charge if the team member participates in the NB Provincial Championships in his/her chosen discipline during the year of his/her application.
16. Team uniforms must be worn at provincial and national championships during opening, closing and medal ceremonies. Team uniforms must also be worn for the duration of competition on the first day of competition for all funded events. **Failure to comply will result in loss of funding for that event.**
17. Archery training expenses (i.e. range fees, gym membership) are the responsibility of the Archer.
18. Team members are expected to compete in no less than 3 local tournaments during the qualification period. Three scores from local events must be submitted in order to participate in the team NB selection process, unless less than 3 target or 3D tournaments appear on ANB’s tournament schedule for the qualification period. Should

this happen, archers may use any other sanctioned tournaments in their discipline including “bigger” tournaments needed for national ranking.

19. ANB’s Board of Directors shall establish via the normal budgeting process separate annual budgets for 3D and Target Teams. It is intended that as many archers (for each teams) as resource permit may participate in National Championships. However, if, in any one year, a team does not use resources fully, the balance will be transferrable to the next year so that resources may be increased in the next year allowing a review of the number of archers to be selected and/or increasing the performance based assistance. Alternatively the Executive Committee and Team Manager may decide to use these surplus funds from the Team NB program for developmental purposes; such as coaching, helping develop facilities or for target availability, etc.

20. A Team Manager shall be appointed for Team NB. The Team Manager may also be the Provincial coach or other person as approved by ANB’s Executive.

Program Specifics:

Coaching & Training (3D and Target)

Each member of the Provincial Team is eligible to receive individual or group coaching.

- Training sessions will be coordinated by the Team Manager.
- All group coaching sessions/clinics must be attended by all team members.
- Training may include, but not be limited to 1) Strength and Conditioning, 2) Sport Psychology, 3) Nutrition, 4) Technical (eg equipment set ups) etc.

Provincial Target Team Selection Criteria

- Archers must participate in one of the following: ANB indoor target provincial championship, Canadian Regional Indoors or Indoor Target Atlantics.
- Archers must participate in 2 of the following outdoor tournaments: ANB outdoor target provincial championship, Outdoor Target Atlantics or Nationals within the last 12 months
- Submit 4 Scores from any Outdoor 720 rounds which exceed the Minimum Qualifying Scores identified in Appendix A within the last 12 months.
- Archers submitting scores for qualifying considerations must be those from outdoor tournaments and submit the score cards signed or scores posted from a verifiable source online (e.g. ANB website).
- In the event that no outdoor provincial tournaments are scheduled then the ANB executive will select another qualifying tournament
- The qualifying period is April 1 of the previous year to March 31 of the current year during which you are applying.
- Scores may only be entered from events open to all competitors and sanctioned by the ANB, Archery Canada, or World Archery.

- To be eligible for funding, Provincial Team Members are required to compete in the category & class in which they qualified.
- PeeWee and Pre-Cub are not part of this program.

Minimum Qualifying Scores (are based on the average of the last 3 year outdoor nationals – Team NB score based on 95% and Team Development based on 90%)

Provincial 3-D Team Selection Criteria

- Archers must participate in one of the following: ANB indoor 3D provincial championship, Indoor 3D Nationals or Indoor 3D Atlantics.
- Archers must participate in 2 of the following outdoor tournaments: ANB outdoor 3D provincial championship, Outdoor 3D Atlantics or Outdoor 3D Nationals within the last 12 months.
- Submit 4 Scores from any Outdoor tournament which exceed the Minimum Qualifying Scores identified in Appendix A within the last 12 months.
- In the event that no Atlantic tournaments are scheduled then the ANB executive will select another qualifying tournament
- Qualification Average based on the average of 40 targets per event. For events that are more than 40 targets, ANB will use the percentage achieved from participation in the event to calculate score for it as a 40 target event.
- The qualifying period is April 1 of the previous year to March 31 of the current year during which you are applying.
- Archers submitting scores for qualifying considerations must be those from outdoor tournaments and submit the score cards signed or scores posted from a verifiable source online (e.g. ANB website).
- To be eligible for funding, Provincial Team Members are required to compete in the category & class in which they qualified.
- Archers, who achieve scores exceeding the Team NB minimum, are eligible for the Provincial Team NB squad. Archers who achieve scores exceeding the Development minimum are eligible for the Provincial Team Development squad.
- Qualifying Base funding scores for all Categories are based on the Archery NB's qualifying scores (see Appendix A) for the appropriate division for the previous year.
- PeeWee and Pre-Cub are not part of this program.

Minimum Qualifying Scores (based on the average of the last 3 year outdoor nationals – Team NB score based on 95% and Team Development based on 90%)

Performance Bonuses (Target Team and 3D Team):

- All categories are eligible for Performance Bonuses.
- Athletes can earn the following Performance Bonuses:
 - The archer who wins Gold in their category at the Canadian National Championships receives a performance bonus based on available funding.
 - The archer who wins Silver in their category at the Canadian National Championships receives a performance bonus based on available funding.

- The archer who wins Bronze in their category at the Canadian National Championships receives a performance bonus based on available funding.
- The archer ranked either 4th or 5th in their competed category at the Canadian National Championships receives a performance bonus based on available funding.

Funding (Target Team and 3D Team)

- Athletes will have the opportunity to increase their funding through Performance Bonuses.
- Funding will be allocated for the shared cost of all expenses, except in the case of per diem allowances. Also covered is the athlete's entry fee. Any travel by air/train will be at the lowest economy fare.
- Funding will be based on 2 levels. Team NB and Team Development will receive funding based on annual budget availability

Financial Support to NB Target Team and 3D Team

The following section describes support that Archery NB could provide to top NB competitive archers based on available resources and archers' performances. The purpose of this program is to assist archers who demonstrate and compete at high levels of competition nationally and internationally so as to improve the number of competitive New Brunswick Archers that participate at National and/or international archery events and competitions.

A budget amount will be approved annually by ANB Board of Directors. For those archers who make the team will receive 30% of their costs based on available funding to attend a national and/or international event. For those archers who did not make the team, however did meet the qualifying scores will receive 20% of their costs based on available funding to attend a national and/or international event.

Archers are to submit a completed expense report along with original receipts within 30 days of the event.
